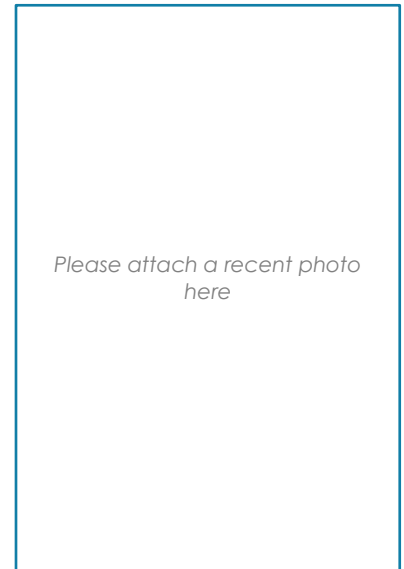

Prerequisites

All grade 10 academic courses and prerequisites must be completed prior to entering the IB programme. Entrance to the IB Programme will be revoked if this criterion is not met.

- Grade 10 Career Life Education; Grade 10 Physical Education; and at least one course of Fine Arts or Life Skills are required for graduation from a BC school.
- You must complete either French or Spanish 9 and 10 prior to IB Diploma studies⁴. Every student must study **two** languages in IB. Challenge language course results **do not** apply to IB studies.
- Completion of Pre-Calculus 11 is **highly recommended** prior to IB Math 11 SL and **mandatory** for IB Math 11 HL. There will be a diagnostic test for all new IB Math HL students in the 1st week of September based on Pre-Calculus 11.
- Physics 11 is required for certain UBC faculties unless a student is awarded a final grade of 5 in IB Math and IB Chemistry.

³ Visual Arts HL is for students with previous art training. Choose a second group 3 or 4 subject if you do not have prerequisite courses in art.

⁴ If you are a new English speaker and you have not had the opportunity to take French or Spanish, you may request to study your home language in a self-taught literature course to fulfill your second language requirement. If you meet the requirements and would like to study the self-taught language course, provide the name of your language here _____. Students taking a self-taught language MUST have a tutor according to IB requirements.
